Full Member

1. Eligible to play in all grass and arena games and practices and coaching league.

Coaching League

1. Introduction to grass. Eligible to play once per week on the grass in controlled instructional chukkas coached by a club professional, play in all arena games.
2. The coaching league games are expected to be Saturday (morning or afternoon), to be announced.
3. Ability to purchase social membership at ½ price.
4. Two guest spectator car day passes for Friday or Sunday admission.

Arena Member

1. Eligible to play in all arena games.
2. Ability to purchase a social membership at ½ price.
3. Two guest spectator car day passes for Friday or Sunday admission.

Student Member

1. Must be a full time student (through 12th grade and University undergrad students) for the coming year, or a graduate of high school/college (Undergrad) in the current year, or those that have completed BPC Orientation to Polo in the current year.
2. Eligible to play in the arena games.

Under 18 Family Member

1. For each additional immediate family member of a full member. Eligible to play in all grass and arena games and grass practices and coaching league. Age limit of less than 18 years.

Under 26 Family Member

1. For each additional immediate family member of a full member. Eligible to play in all grass and arena games and grass practices and coaching league. Age limit of less than 26 years.

Professional Member

1. For players primarily making a living as a professional polo player.
2. Eligible to play in all grass and arena games, and practice sessions.
3. Professional members are expected to help out with club duties.
